



## Northwest Florida Volunteer Firefighter Weekend Required Prerequisite Training For Live Fire Evolutions

This 8-hour course for volunteer firefighters will consist of live fire training evolutions, with the live fire training to take place at Northwest Florida State College. The live fire evolutions will place the students in controlled situations with experienced LFTI instructors and safety officers. The ICS system will be used on scene and all Firefighters will be made familiar with the system operation on the day of the program.

All participants are required to bring NFPA approved bunker gear to include helmet, hood, gloves, bunker boots and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus. Gear inspection will be carried out at the beginning of the course.

To take advantage of this training, and earn credit for control burns towards FFI certification, the following training ***MUST HAVE BEEN COMPLETED*** prior to attending this course:
