Instructions for completing the application

- The Council will sponsor a blended Firefighter I class at a host fire department. Firefighter I Task Book Second Signature Sign-off and live burn to be completed at our annual event; or
- By attending and successfully completing the 2nd signature for the Florida Firefighter I Skills Task Book and Live Fire Evolutions at our annual event, or
- By attending and successfully completing the S130/S190 at our annual event, or
- The Council will assist a fire departments online Firefighter I class with Florida Firefighter I Task Book First Signature Sign-off. Firefighter I Task Book Second Signature Sign-off and live burn to be completed at our annual event; or
- The Council will assist a fire department(s) Firefighter I class with the Florida Firefighter I Task Book Second Signature Sign-off

1. The Council will sponsor one SAFER funded online Firefighter I class in Florida in 2015.
2. The award will be based on financial need of the fire department and the number of students registering for the class.
3. The fire department will agree to fund the class/students. Upon the students successful completion of the Firefighter I training as per FAC 69A-37 and receiving their "Certificate of Completion of Firefighter Part I Curriculum" from the Florida State Fire College, the Council will reimburse the department for the cost of the online class.
4. Deadline for submission of this application is June 1, 2015.
5. Notification of the award will be on June 15, 2015 by e-mail to the fire chief.

7. Class dates are scheduled for July through September with lecture and skills training conducted on Saturday and Sunday.
